



## Race Officer crib-sheet 27/10/2020 (handicap)

Refer to the TYC Race Officer Guidelines for full details.

- Decide if conditions to race are OK. River flow? Too windy? No SB?
- Set your course. Inform competitors/up or down stream finish.
- Record on race sheet who's competing: Boat name and number, helm and crew.
- Have clock/timer ready to read
- Check walkie-talkie comms with SB
- Set-up the flags/boards with colours facing away from river initially
- Decide race start time and write this on race sheet HH:MM:SS Typically 11:05:00



11:00 Hoist handicap flag and sound warning.	➔			
11:01 Hoist Preparatory flag and sound warning.	➔			
11:04 lower Preparatory flag and sound warning.	➔			
11:05 lower Handicap flag and sound warning. <b>Record time as race start HH:MM:SS</b>	➔			

- Record competitors position as they complete each lap.
- Continue race for approximately an hour while recording lap positions up to 6.
- As each boat completes the final lap sound the signal and record their time HH:MM:SS
- Other considerations: Refer to guidelines doc for.. shorten coarse if required, boats over the start line at start.
